

# DION'S DRESS CODE

## EXEMPLIFYING EXCEPTIONAL PEOPLE

Our vision is to be the **most admired** regional restaurant brand in the country. Our **dress code** plays a substantial role in this vision. We expect every employee in the company to present themselves properly according to our dress code. Our dress code also serves a functional purpose to keep our employees and our food safe.

Your **leadership** is reflected through your appearance therefore we expect **excellence** to be reflected in your **dress code**. We expect all employees to show up to work presentable and respectable every day!

### BEARDS.

#### Or moustaches!

If you are going to keep a beard or moustache it must be neatly trimmed to 1/4 inch in length to prevent physical contamination.

### HAIR. The mane event

Hair must be of a natural or neutral color. For women, all hair shoulder length or longer must be worn up through the hole in your hat and restrained. Men, hair length is to be kept no longer than the top of the collar.

### HATS.

#### To top it all off

Your Dion's hat must be properly worn at all times in the kitchen to prevent any physical contamination of our food.

### JACKETS.

#### Coat drive

No personal coats or jackets are allowed to be worn in the kitchen. Drive Thru jackets are allowed for Drive Thru runners only.

### FINGERNAILS.

#### Au naturel

Dion's does not allow fingernail polish (including gel or clear) or artificial finger nails. These can chip off and fall into our customers food.

### JEWELRY.

#### Little bit o' bling

In order to keep our food safe, only one ring per hand may be worn. No bracelets or watches. Necklaces can be worn under your uniform. Ladies, only two earrings per ear may be worn, men, please remove any earrings while on shift.

### PANTS. Denim. Period.

Pants must be denim jeans in either blue, black, or grey. Pants have to be denim because that is the only material that will protect your skin from burns! Make sure they are in good condition free of holes, rips and frayed edges, they must cover you up from waist to shoe!

### SHOES.

#### Be kind to your feet

You must wear athletic shoes in good condition that cover all parts of your feet. This will prevent burns. You will be on your feet a lot, make sure they give good support!



### SHIRTS.

#### Butter tuck it in!

Keep your shirts lookin' nice! They must be clean and free of graffiti. They must remain a bright yellow color and be tucked in at all times. Long sleeve shirts are not allowed to be worn under your uniform shirt.

### APRONS.

#### Cover up Buttercup!

Aprons must be clean and look neat, it makes a good first impression and keeps our food safe!

### NAME TAGS.

#### Lookin' sharp

Name tags let people know who you are. Make sure they are clean, not drawn on and are always on the left side of your apron with your name only.

### PIERCINGS.

#### Less is more

Dion's does not allow any facial piercings including tongue rings, nose rings, or visible body rings of any kind. Clear spacers for any body piercings are not allowed. Ear piercings bigger than a 2 gauge are not allowed. Ladies, you may wear two earrings per ear, gentlemen, no earrings allowed on shift.

### TATTOOS. Nope

Dion's does not allow visible tattoos or branding. If you have a tattoo or brand that shows when you are standing at rest in full uniform, you are out of integrity with our dress code. Visible tattoos may not be covered by bandages or makeup.
