

DION'S DRESS CODE

HAVE PRIDE IN YOUR PERSONAL APPEARANCE, ALWAYS BE IN DRESS CODE

Our dress code and uniforms are a direct reflection of our brand's reputation and is designed to keep our employees safe while at work, and our food safe from contaminants.

DION'S ISSUED UNIFORM

All uniforms must be clean, free of markings, accessories, and graffiti.

Shirt must be tucked in at all times. Long sleeve shirts are not allowed.

Apron must be clean.

Name tag must be worn on the left side of your apron.

Handwritten names are not allowed and only your name should be on the name tag.

Dion's hat must be worn facing forward.

Personal coats and jackets are not allowed to be worn in the kitchen.



HAIR, NAILS & MAKEUP

Hair below the collar must be effectively restrained.

Shoulder-length or longer hair must be in a bun or braid.

Bangs that fall below the eyebrows must be covered by your hat.

Beards and mustaches must be trimmed to 1/4 inch or shorter.

Fingernail polish including gel, clear, or artificial nails are not allowed.

Makeup must be moderate, extreme makeup is not allowed.

Visible hickeys are not allowed.

Face applications are not allowed.

JEANS & SHOES

Denim jeans must be blue, black, or gray in a solid color and in good condition. Jeans are not to be worn below the waist or in a baggy manner. Jeans must be full length and cover from waist to shoes.

Athletic shoes must have functioning shoelaces and in good condition.

TATTOOS

Tattoos on the face, throat, or visible neckline are not allowed.

Tattoos that are offensive or inappropriate for work are not allowed.

Tattoos that violate the policy cannot be covered with bandages, makeup, or non-uniform clothing.

PIERCINGS & ACCESSORIES

One plain **band/ring** may be worn.

Bracelets or watches are not allowed.

Necklaces must be worn under your uniform.

Earrings worn can not be dangling or hoops larger than a quarter.

Gauges larger than a size two are not allowed.

One small **nose stud** is allowed. Nose hoops (rings), septum, dermal, facial, or mouth piercings are not allowed.

Lanyards, wallet chains, or hanging accessories are not allowed.

Employees must be in complete dress code while on the clock, including prep and close.
